Course Introduction

The course, Introduction to public policy and governance, provide a broad overview to the public policy process in Myanmar, examines how public policy affects people's lives, and introduces toolkits for analyzing and evaluating public policy. This course introduces students to the essential ideas, process, and challenges of public policy and governance in a time when the country is facing profound political, social, and economic uncertainty. It helps students to understand how public problems are identified, how policies are formed, and how institutions shape peoples' daily lives. Specific contexts are considered to Myanmar current context, including issues of conflict, displacement, inequality, service delivery gaps, and the struggles for justice accountability, and inclusive governance.
